

#### **Councilor Corner**

The Fall 2022 National Meeting in Chicago was conducted in a hybrid format. The Council Meeting was held in a hybrid manner on August 24, 2022.

Highlights from the 2022 Fall Council Meeting:

- 1. The fall 2022 meeting was held in a hybrid manner from August 21-25. As of August 24, there were 11,619 registrations (9,355 in-person and 2,264 virtual).
- 2. Council elected members to fill positions on several Committees of Council: Council Policy Committee (CPC), Committee on Committees (ConC), and Committee on Nominations and Elections (N&E).
- 3. Council voted to approve several items listed in the agenda for Council Action.
- 4. President Wilson introduced and led a special discussion on "ACS for the Future." She sought Councilor input on positive initiatives, programs or events that would greatly benefit ACS members or ACS at large. Councilors provided their ideas and thoughts, and relevant Society units will receive this input within the next several weeks.
- CEO Search: CEO Thomas Connelly announced his retirement in May and the Board discussed the search for the next CEO. The search is now underway with the goal of identifying candidates, interviewing them and selecting our next CEO with a targeted start date of January 1, 2023.














The Midland College Chemistry Club participated in the ChemClash event on October 18th, 2022

National Chemistry Week October 16-22, 2022


Theme: Fabulous Fibers: The Chemistry of Fabrics

National Chemistry Week (NCW) is an annual community outreach program hosted by the American Chemical Society (ACS), the world's largest scientific society. It is designed to show how chemistry supports everyone and contributes to our quality of life and the nation's economy. NCW is celebrated throughout the country by all 185 local sections of the ACS. NCW began as National Chemistry Day in 1987 and was expanded to a week-long celebration in 1989.

This year's NCW theme is "Fabulous Fibers." With assistance from students, staff, volunteers from ACS local sections and chemistry clubs across the country will be involved in activities that highlight the important role that chemistry plays in our lives. Varied activities are held during NCW, including many hands-on experiments designed for children. All experiments and other activities are conducted and supervised by chemists, with safety and learning as the top priorities. Other activities include Element Contest, T-Shirt Design Contest, Lab Coat – Tie Dye Event from, J&L Laboratory Tour, UTPB's Dr. Montes Talk at Midland College, and Chemistry at the Midland Mall.
